ANNUAL REPORT 2022-2023

The academic year 2022-23 got a sprightly start on 4th April 2022 amidst prayers and expectations.

To promote an English friendly atmosphere and to create opportunities for students to develop and express their linguistic skills, the English club, ANGLOZONE was inaugurated on 17th June 2022 and is functioning at its best.

International Yoga Day was celebrated on 22nd June 2022 by the VPS fraternity with great enthusiasm. Our senior students participated in a huge event organized by the District Administration in Nehru stadium and demonstrated various asanas and exercises.

CCA ACTIVITIES:



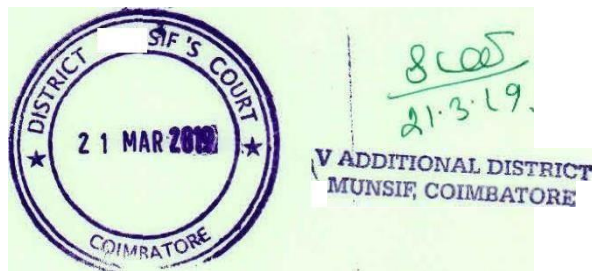
